## **VIDEO EDITING WITH YOUTUBE**


- 1. Log in to YouTube with your calcoisd account.
- 2. In the upper-right-hand corner, click "Upload."

\*If you want to upload video clips to edit, in the center,

- a. Change the setting:
  - If you make the video "private," you'll have to enter the CCISD email of each person you want to share it with.
  - If you make it "unlisted," you can share the link for others to watch
  - If you make it "public," anyone in the world can watch it. This might pose problems, so it's best not to use this option.
- b. Click the arrow and choose the video to upload



c. When the video is finished uploading, at the bottom, click *Video Manager* 



d. You will see a list of all the videos you have uploaded. On the left, click *Create* and then *Video Editor*.


\*If your video clips are already uploaded, click Edit under "Video editor."



- 3. At the top next to "Project," enter a name for your video.
- 4. To make the video, click and drag clips down to the timeline.




5. To edit the video as a whole: click on the movie camera under the video. This is the menu for editing the video as a whole:



6. To edit a single video clip: on the timeline, click on the video clip. The clip will look similar to this:


This is the menu for editing a single video clip:



- 7. When all edits have been made, click Create Video.
- 8. On the left, click Videos.
- 9. Next to the video you want to share, click *Edit*
- 10. In the upper-right-hand corner of the video, click the share icon.



11. Right-click on the link that appears and choose "Copy."



## 12. For Teachers:

a. Paste that link into Google Classroom or the document you will share with students.

## For Students:

a. Add to a Google Classroom assignment or email the link to the teacher.
