2024-2025 FAFSA Instructions

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is an annual application used to determine your eligibility for federal student aid for one academic year. After completing your 2024-2025 FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov, you will receive a FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS)

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA application as soon as possible after January 1, 2024, at www.fafsa.ed.gov. You must include the student and parent's income. A hard copy of the FAFSA can be obtained from your school's Financial Aid Office but will take longer to process.
- 2. Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool for easier processing. The Data Retrieval Tool allows students and parents to access the IRS tax return information needed to complete the FAFSA. Students and parents may transfer the data directly into their FAFSA. If you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, we highly recommend using the tool for several reasons:
 - It is the easiest way to provide your tax data.
 - It is the best way of ensuring that your FAFSA has accurate tax information.
 - You will not need to provide a copy of your or your parents' tax returns to your college for verification.

If you do not use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to provide tax information and your college requests a copy of your tax return or your parents' tax return, you may be required to obtain an official tax transcript from the IRS.

3. After you submit the FAFSA, you should receive an email from FAFSA within 3 to 5 days with instructions on how to access an online copy of your FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS), which will include your Student Aid Index (SAI). You will only have to print out the first page of the FSS report, not all 10 pages. If you do not provide a valid email address on your FAFSA application, your FSS will be mailed to you within 7 to 10 days. You can also retrieve the FSS by logging onto the FAFSA website. After login, click View Processed Information and choose the pdf version of the FSS. Save it on your computer.
